Good Things Come in Threes

Kitchen Defeats Loons for Third Title.

ANCHORAGE – On Sunday night, the Tennessee Titans played the Indianapolis Colts for the final NFL playoff spot. With 38 seconds left, Titans' backup QB Kerry Collins kneed the ball. This simple gesture secured victory for the Anchorage Kitchen. Outside the TFL, no one even batted an eyelash. Everyone associated with the league, however, knew the significance of the win.

The 40-16 thrashing of the Limerick Laughing Loons was Nate Sagan's third Sweeney Bowl victory, making him the first owner to reach the three-T. Rex milestone. In an e-mail not long after the game was finished, Nate Sagan expressed his thoughts, "...I can tell you it's a very special feeling. I'm just glad I could represent the town of Anchorage and all the Kitchen fans that were so loyal all year long."

Anchorage's dominance in the title game only strengthened their reputation as one of the TFL's premier teams. Over the past three years they have won 26 regular season games, one regular season title, and 2 championships. Don't be surprised if they have a mediocre year next season, though. The Kitchen had losing seasons after both of their previous championships, including a 3-11 finish in 1996. On the other hand we can never know for sure. One thing's for certain: Whatever happens next year will be exciting. I mean, it's the Times Football League; everybody's talkin' about it!

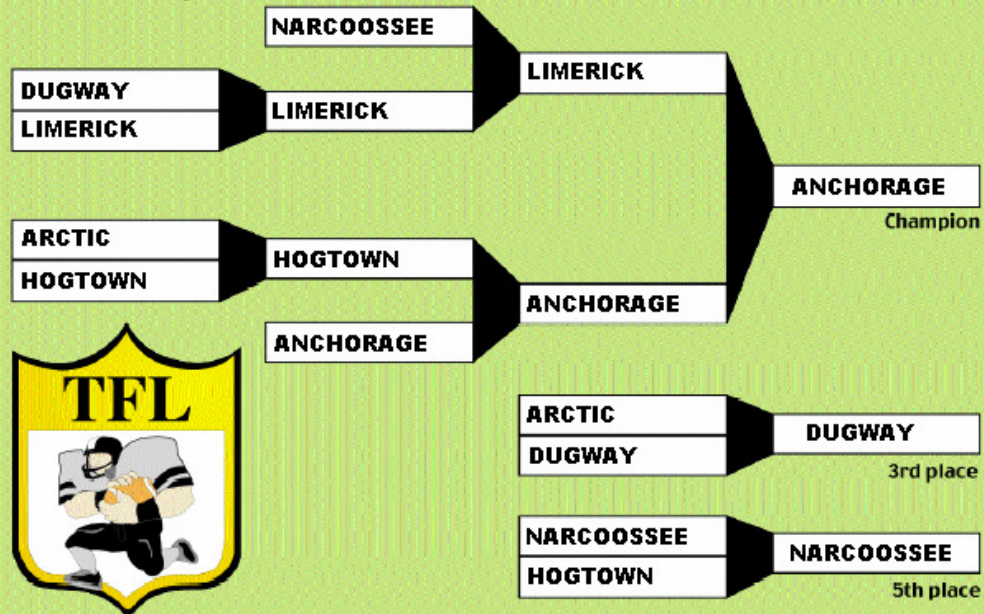


Nate Sagan became the first TFL owner to win the T. Rex three times.

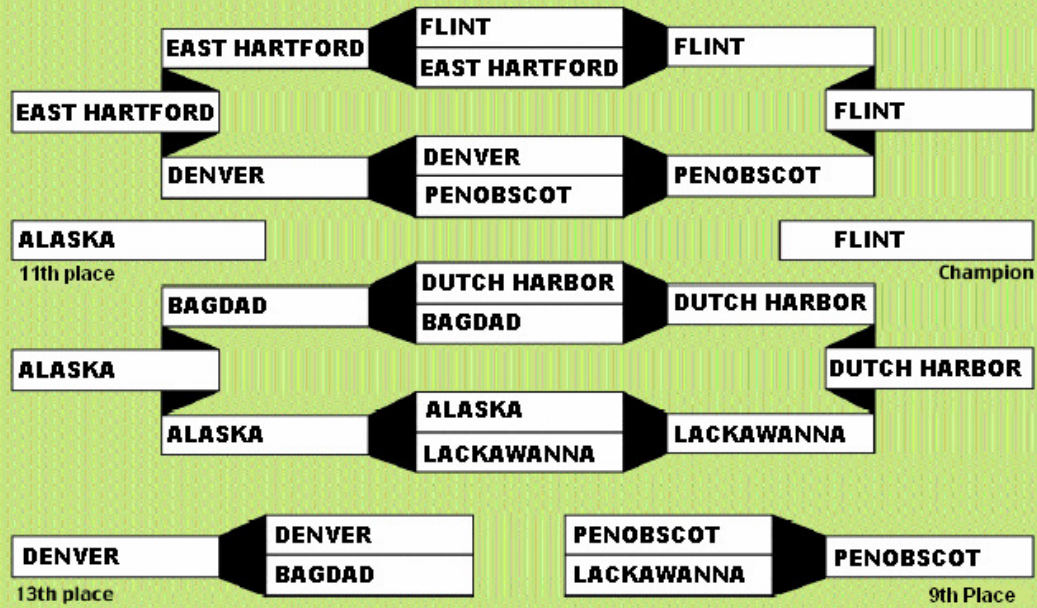
