I THE PLAYOFFS.

- 1. Should the teams In the playoffs be Reseeded after the wildcard round?
- 2. Should the Pee Wee Tournament be reseeded as its own entity? Once the 6th and final team qualifies for the Sweeney Bowl Tournament, should the remaining 8 be seeded separately?
- 3. Should 3-way ties be broken as they are now, with the tiebreakers applied to all three teams simultaneously, or should the tiebreaker be used to qualify one team, then get reapplied to the remaining two tied teams?

II THE PLAYERS.

- 1. Are we all agreed that pure free agent pickups end with the end of the regular season, and only injury moves are allowed once the playoffs start?
- 2. Yes or no: A trade is defined as a straight-across exchange of players between two teams. If a trade leaves one of the rosters imbalanced, and the owner in question, knowing this, picks up a free agent to fill out the depleted position on his roster, that part is charged.
- 3. Owners involved in a trade must consummate it in full the day they execute it, rather than having until game day to flesh out rosters.

- 4. Should an owner be allowed to fill a standard, TFL team roster of 12 slots with any combination of players he wishes, without the rule requiring a specific number at any one position, or should the 12 remain defined as 2 QB, 3 RB, 3 WR, 2 K, 2 D?
- 5. In light of our "immediateeligible" rule on free agents, and considering the NFL injury report doesn't come out until Thursday, should owners ...
- A. be allowed to put a player on I. R. on Tuesday if he came out of a game hurt, pick up a replacement, and then pay the \$5 tranny fee by midnight Thursday if the injured player is not on that day's injury report?
- B. have the option of that or just rescinding the move by midnight Thursday, releasing the replacement pickup and keeping the injured player active?
- 6. When you reactivate a player (i. e. a running back) who has been on IR, should you have to drop the person you had picked up to fill his spot, or just be allowed to drop any of your backs?
- 6. Yes or no: Injured players returning to active status must be actively and responsibly reinstated by their owner by midnight Wednesday, or they return to the talent pool. It's not automatic, as is reactivation on a bye-week reserve move.




