"Of course I'm very impressed, but I'm not shocked at all," said Steve Spurrier, longtime advisor and assistant with the Arctic Gators. He knows how to put a team together and get the most out of his personnel. I'd be nervous if I had to face him this season and I'm just thankful he's not coaching in our league"

Spurrier is currently the head coach of the NFL Washington Redskins.
