# A Favre Cry From His Former Greatness

On the verge of being an Ex-football team, the Ex'mos waive their No. 1 pick 3 games into the season

HEBRON -- All day Monday, East Hartford owner Chris Reidy drove around town, a look of either shame or frustration on his face. He was contemplating a bold move, one almost as bold (if you think "bold" can sometimes mean "stupid") as trading away Kurt Warner last season.

Nightfall came, and still Reidy wasn't sure he could bring himself to do it. Then, like one last swig from a bottle of bourbon, came the 10 little words that gave him the courage.

"The Exmos hope Brett Favre starts playing football pretty soon."

That concise comment, from TFL Scoring Central's recap of yet another Ex-Eskimos loss, crystalized the problem for Reidy. In a move that sent shock waves throughout the TFL -- or, at least as far as Marlborough -- the Exmos cut No. 1 draft pick Brett Favre, picking up promising young quarterback Tim Couch to replace him.



"Look, I'll admit it, I never should have drafted him in the first place," Reidy said at his weekly press conference. "But, for chrissakes, ZERO points against the Eagles? At home? C'mon now. Anything from him -- anything -- and we'd have won that game."

Instead, the Exmos find themselves in decidedly unfamiliar territory. Their 30-26 loss to the Willow Weasels dropped them to 0-3 -- an ominous note in Exmoland. The only other time the Exmos opened 0-3 -- in fact, the only other season in which they lost an opener -- was the 4-10 disaster of 1994. That re-

mains East Hartford's only losing season in its eightyear history.

Perhaps the most frightening harbinger was that both those starts came on the shoulders of unworthy No. 1 draft picks. The culprit in '94 was Jerome Bettis, whose only applicable nickname that season could be "The Bust."

So, was Reidy officially pinning Favre with scapegoat status for this year?

"Well, that all depends on your definition of 'scapegoat,'" Reidy said, in an uncharacteristically challenging tone. "If you media types choose to define a scapegoat as someone who is assigned sole responsibility, fairly or unfairly, for the failure of an endeavor ... then yes, I guess you could say Favre was a scapegoat."

To be sure, the Exmos' failings have been many, leaving them with the fourthlowest point total in the

TFL. The running backs, an area Reidy likes to consider the strength of his team, have produced one touchdown in three games. And No. 2 pick Isaac Bruce was virtually invisible until last week, when he produced all but eight of the Exmos' points.

But Reidy pointed to Favre as the root cause.

"Look, when I've seen him play, he just hasn't looked good," Reidy said. "Week 1 against the Jets, he had his man open on the sideline for what should have been the winning TD pass, but just plain short-armed that ball. And I couldn't get the image out of my mind of him constantly holding that sore elbow -- the one that's mentioned on the injury report every week.

"I don't know, maybe he's spent a few too many weeks shining his trophies, if you know what I mean."

At that, Reidy feigned

an arm motion that looked vaguely like someone wiping the varnish from a cherished memento -- albeit a memento that was being held slightly below waist level, and being cleaned with only one hand.

Reidy also seemed unfazed at the thought of enduring more Warnerian levels of criticism for dropping a three-time NFL MVP onto the free agent market -- this time, without even seeking an Adrian Murrell in exchange. Come to think of it, maybe the Exmos got the same thing in return both times.

"Hey, I'm sure someone will pick him up, he'll suddenly remember who the fuck he is and take someone to the playoffs, " Reidy said. "More power to him. Yeah, I hope he becomes TFL Fucking Comeback Player of the Year."

The only market for Favre was Bagdad and Limerick, and Bagdad got him.


LIMERICK, Maine - Were it not for the cursed game-day machinations of the mind of Mike Shanahan, this could have been one of the best battles of running backs you'll see all year. But Terrell Davis was benched by Denver just before game time, and it was left for Limerick's Marshall Faulk to own center stage against the Bagdad Newts.

And own it he did. Three scores, plus yardage points both rushing and receiving, produced 23 points to Davis' big blank in the Loons' romp over the Newts, giving Limerick one of the TFL's three 3-0 records. Both Faulk and the Loons have the TFL's second-most points.
