

game against Kansas City, Barons owner Steve Katz made an emergency call to Flint headquarters.

"Donny, call off the dogs,"
Katz pleaded to an answering
machine, which took the call
because the Bison's Don Carlock was playing in an all-youcan-eat-and-drink, chili-and-beer
golf tournament, which he hasn't
even said anything about yet.

Flint's Drew Bledsoc and
Robert Edwards had already
produced 24 points between
them, and it seemed every time Katz
flipped the channel back to the
game, there was another New England touchdown, and one of them
was scoring it.


Thirty points just from those two players by halftime, and 33 in all, spelled the end for Baltimore, which fell to 2-4 in the ugliest division in this or any other league, real or imagined, this side of the NFC East.

Bagdad team (see lead story, if he wrote one) that
picked up Rodney Peete as an 11th-hour byereserve quarterback.

And Dutch Harbor fell to 1-5 at the hands of a suddenly not so woeful Dugway.

And that's the division. 3-3 leads it, followed by a couple of 2-4's and a 1-5. Which is exactly why Katz wasn't worried.

His stoicism matched only by his bravery, Katz unblinkingly said, "We're not hurting. The first-place team is just as shitty as anybody, and this week the Weasels play Denver, which returns all of its best players from byes. If Denver wins and we bury Dugway, we're in the same boat as everybody around us."
