## Inside the numbers Limerick best at avoiding dead week

So now we know the Denver Pyles are the unluckiest team in TFL history (and the luckiest), and that Dugway's Ken Sain is a whiny blowhard whose claims of misfortune will never withstand the unbending truth of mathematical analysis.

But recently we've been wondering about team scoring streaks. Good ones and bad ones. Curious, we scrambled into the TFL command center to consult our trusty Access database.

First, the good streaks. We started out by searching for the teams that managed to avoid the dreaded 'dead week' - defined here as scoring fewer than 20 points — for the longest span of time. There were a few candidates for this award, including Barbarino Division rivals Dugway and Denver, who both have posted 39-game streaks in this category.

The record? Two-time Sweeney Bowl champion \*Limerick, at 46 games. In fact, the Loons streak of 20-point games was active until two weeks ago, when it was snapped in a 65-9 loss to Lackawanna.

The longest active streak? Dutch Harbor, at 27.

Raising the bar, we turned our attention to teams who scored 40 or more points in the most consecutive weeks. Not much of a contest here. The leader, far and away, is East Hartford, with 10 straight 40point outings in 1998. Not coincidentally, that was the same season East Hartford's Steve Young set the TFL scoring record with 266 points.

Moving on. Sixty or more points? Well, no team has done that more twice in a row. But one of those teams, Lackawanna, has posted 60point outing just these last two

weeks. The Lancers go for the record this weekend against Dutch Harbor.

Now for the flip side. Futility streaks.

We started out at the 50-point threshold. Which team couldn't hit that target over the longest period of time? Well, that would be America's favorite Special Olympians - the Denver Pyles. During an astounding run of ineptitude, the Pyles suited up 34 straight games without scoring 50 points in any of them. No other team even approaches that mark.

But give the Arctic Gators a year or two. The Gators haven't scored more than 50 points since Week 4 of last year, a streak of 15, the longest such active streak in the league. Can Arctic run the streak to 35? Let's put it this way: we like Gators owner Mark Dolan's chances.

Of course, scoring 50 points isn't a gimme for any team. But 20 points? Should be easy, right? So which sadsack units have failed to amass that measly amount in the most consecutive games? Here we have a tie, at three games, between Narcoossee and Sarasota.

But we're going to award this one to the Sharks on account of a remarkable stat. In 1997, the year of Sarasota's streak, the Sharks scored 20 or fewer points in seven games, including a remarkable run of five times in six outings.

And how did Coggins celebrate his dubious foray into the record books? He retired.

#### 8. 1993 Alaska Oosiks Were 3-11 and scored estimated 458 points (records incomplete). Charles' worst team ever.




7. 1992 Maryland Mania Were 3-11 and scored esti-

# Defending champs on pace to be awful

There has been a lot of debate about which team in the Times Football League could claim to be the best in league history.

But no one has ever tried to identify the worst team of all time. Until now.

Exactly why should we ponder this now? Simple, it appears the defending champion Baltimore Barons are about to claim that crown for their own, so it would be nice to know whom they are stealing it from.

The 2001 Barons are 0-5 and on a pace to score only 294 points this season. Nine teams in the 11-year history of the TFL have finished with as few as three victories during the regular season. That record-no-onewants is in within Steve Katz's reach.

If Katz does claim the worst-ever crown this season, he will be stealing it off the head of Sarasota Sharks owner Charlie Coggins.

The 1997 Sharks were clearly the worst team in league history. Only one other team has ever finished with less points scored in a season, and that was before 1995 (the year scoring dramatically increased because of new rules on defensive players in the NFL).

That awful Sharks team did have some competition, though. In the 11year history of the TFL, nine teams have tied the mark for worst record at 3-11. Each made the list of top 10 worst teams in TFL history.

For the tenth, we took the team that set the record for fewest points in a season and the only team to ever be shutout in a TFL game, the 1990 Arctic Gators, which through pure luck managed a 7-7 record.

That gave Mark Dolan three of the top 10 worst teams in TFL history. Joining him with multiple teams are

Katz and Nate Sagan. Those three owners account for seven of the top 10 worst teams.

The other three belong to Coggins, Charles Bingham and Robert Garcia/Desiree Humphries' 1991 Ninja. But Katz may have competition. Bagdad has been able to squeak out two victories, but the Newts are on a pace to score only 353 points this season.

East Hartford, Narcoossee and Dugway are all 1-4. Narcoossee has been dealt the league's toughest schedule. The Grape Apes opponents are averaging 45.2 points a game.

Still, after a disastrous draft caused by a temporarily insane owner's trade, the Barons stand alone as favorite to be the worst.
