But as his new motto states, "I'm 5-2, so fuck all of you." It goes right next to UFOs and

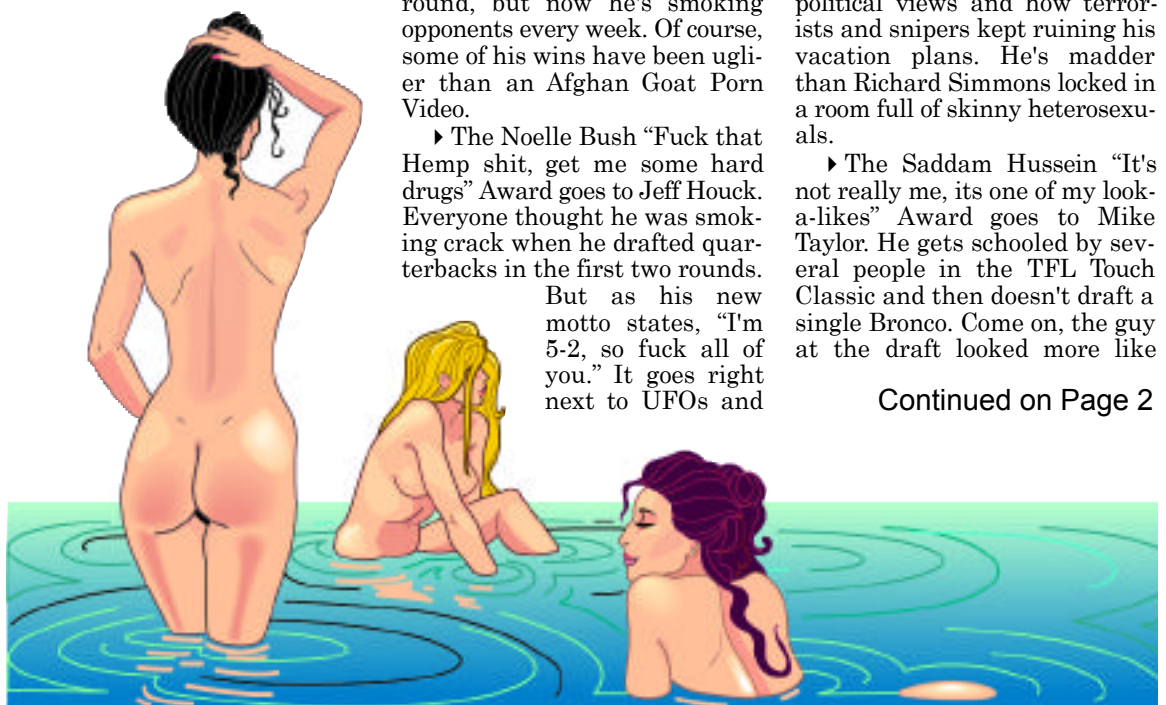
thong bathing suits for guys as one of the world's great mysteries.

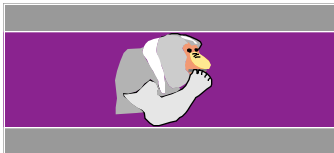


Lackawanna at Anchorage
