Expansion committee says no to expanding playoffs

The white smoke poured out of the chimney. A faint odor of Totino's and stale Budweiser filled the air as the front door opened. The world seemed to pause as it became apparent that the powerful TFL Expansion Committee had ended its six-week deliberation.

The three-man committee stepped onto the front porch of the Loon Mountain Resort and toward the nest of hastily arranged microphones.

"We have come to a decision," announced Flint Bison owner Don Carlock. According to longtime league observers, Carlock, along with Limerick owner and two-time Sweeney Bowl champion Michael Bourque and Bagdad's Scott Lacy, formed a triumvirate charged with resolving the most vexing issue ever addressed by the league.

The committee released its decision which was scrawled on the inside of a Totino's pizza box. The decision is to be considered and

eventually voted upon by league owners.

The Criteria While deciphering the actions of the committee proved challenging to this reporter, most analysts agreed that their action can be summarized as follows:

The TFL should expand to 16 teams in four four-team divisions

■ Expansion teams should be selected through an application process that would use the following criteria as a way of prioritizing potential owners

1. A Times Sports employ-

ee from the years 1989-1992.

2. Any Times employee from the years 1989-1992.

3. A previous TFL owner.

4. A friend of Times employees during the years 1989-1992.

5. A connection to Alaska print journalism during years 1989-1992.

6. A friend of multiple TFL owners in the years since the paper's folding.

7. An incredibly charismatic, well-

rounded, interesting friend of any one TFL owner who dreams of being in the TFL.

Said the cryptic Lacy: "I'd say it's roughly a hierarchy of similar experience."

Playoff and Payout Carlock added some clarification about how this process would impact the pot of the Sweeney Bowl winner as well as the implications for the SB and Pee Wee playoffs. This configuration would keep the current number of playoff teams. Instead of the current three wild card entries,

Carlock has Bison off to a 1994 start

Ken Sain is whining again. And this time he may be on to something.

What's his fuss? The Flint Bison — and their uncanny resemblance to a legendary Flint team of the past.

"This is starting to look just like 1994 all over again," Sain said.

The 1994 Bison, in case you have forgotten, were a team of quantifiable destiny. Widely derided after a draft in which rookie owner Don

Carlock seemed confused and overmatched, the Bison became one of the greatest teams in TFL history. And one of the luckiest.

The Bison won four games that year by a margin of five points or less, including a 62-60 victory in the season opener. Carlock rode his team's propitious tendencies to a 13-game winning streak and finished the season 13-1. No TFL team has matched that record in the seven seasons since.

Enter the 2001 team. Carlock and the Bison are at it again, and in the process, might be penning an even more compelling story than in 1994. The Bison have sprinted to a 6-0 start, with five of the six victories attained by a margin of five points or fewer (the other victory was a nine-point 'blowout').

Just as in 1994, the Bison have displayed an uncanny knack for producing just enough to win in every scenario. When Bagdad posted a feeble 12-point outing in Week 2, the Bison efficiently rang up 13. Three weeks later, Willow popped for 54 points, but no worry — Flint

reached into its bag and came up with 59.

Just how unlikely is this? We examined all the game scores from 1994 and 2001 and discovered this

remarkable fact: no team won more than five games by a margin of five points or fewer in an *entire* season!

There are other similarities between the 1994 and 2001 Bison teams. Both were carried by their QBs — Dan

Marino in 1994, and Daunte Culpepper in 2001. Culpepper, in fact, has been Flint's leading scorer in all six games this year.

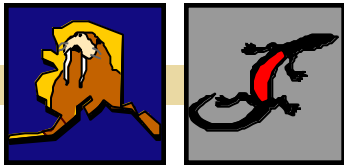
And in an eerie resemblance to 1994, the Bison are once again eclipsing a fantastic season by the Lackawanna Lancers, who are 5-1 and have scored a league-leading 303 points. Seven years ago, in the shadow of Flint's 13-1 season, the Lancers quietly finished 10-4 and scored a league-high 599 points.

Of course, Carlock is probably hoping that 2001 doesn't completely follow the 1994 script. Why? After leading the 1994 Bison to 13 victories and the regular season championship, Carlock's first-year wonders bowed out quietly in the first round of the playoffs. And unlike so many of their games that season, it wasn't even close — Lackawanna won 47-14.

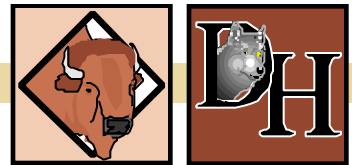

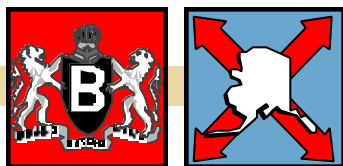

Timeline

1. TFL owners voted to expand to 16 teams for the 2002 season.
2. Then-Commissioner Steve Katz appointed Michael Bourque, Don Carlock and Scott Lacy to an expansion committee to make recommendations about how to expand and which new teams should be added.
3. The expansion committee will solicit applications for the two expansion franchises.
4. The committee will then review the applications and make its recommendations to all current owners.
5. All owners will vote on the recommendations of the committee.

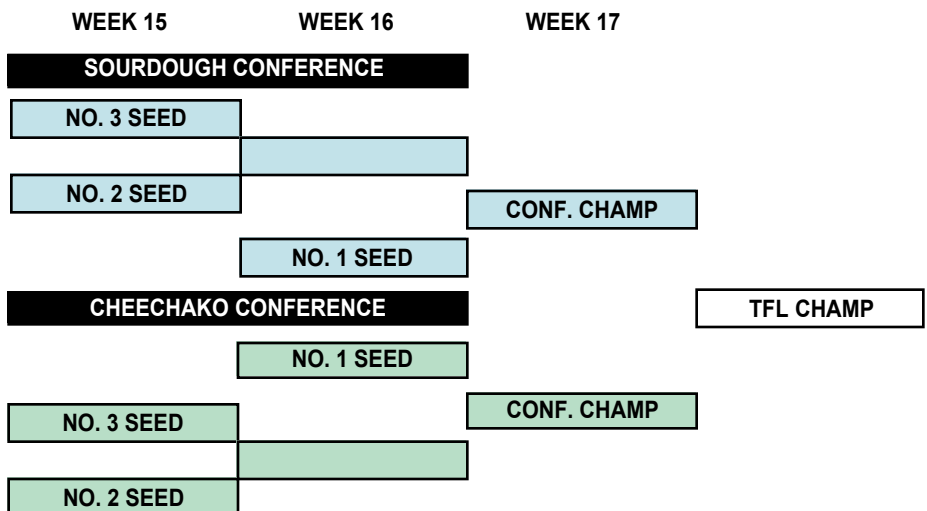

The playoffs

The Totinos Expansion Committee's first major recommendation is that the league not increase the number of teams in the Sweeney Bowl Tournament nor Pee Wee Bowl Tournament. Six would qualify for the Sweeney, and eight for the Pee Wee, leaving the two teams with the worst records sitting out the final three weeks of the season.

The committee members believe this will increase the amount of money paid to the winners and force teams at the bottom to remain interested to get into the playoffs.

there would be four division winners and two wild cards. As is the case now, the two teams with the best records would earn a bye in the first round of the playoffs. The Pee Wee tournament would continue with the same number of teams, meaning that the two worst teams suffer the ultimate ignominy (other than losing to Katz) and would not qualify for either playoff.

The Application Process

The committee acknowledged that it was the interest of so many would-be TFLers who helped force the league to come to grips with its popularity and led it to consider expansion. Bourque encouraged application from any who are interested. Applicants will be asked to consider the following questions. Their answers will be printed in TFL Today, giving owners the information necessary to vote on their potential entry into the league.

While an application was still being designed, the following ques-

tions seemed destined to be part of the process.

- Why do you want to be in the TFL?
- What can you add to the TFL — e.g., writing for newsletter, organizing conventions, or other skills that might help the league innovate and run more efficiently?
- How long do you expect to remain in the TFL?
- How long have you wanted to be in the TFL?
- How often would you attend TFL conventions (every year, often, occasionally, never).
