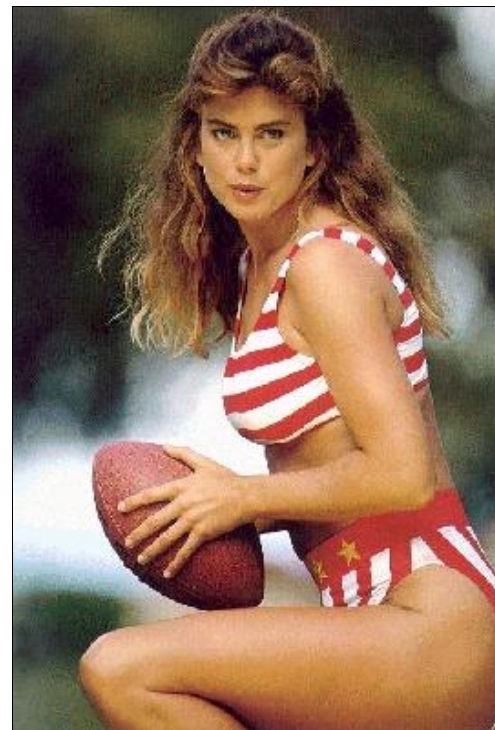

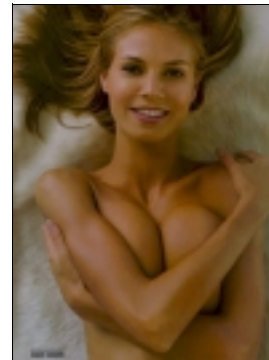

Tally ho, old chap! The Nose Apes seem to roll no matter Brett Favre's mediocrity. Will they lose again?



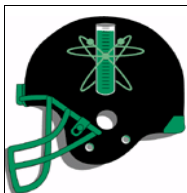
**Anchorage (5-5) at Flint (3-7)

The law of averages should come into play in this game. These teams are both average.



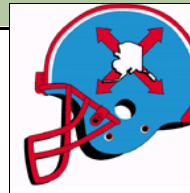
**Baltimore (5-5) at Dugway (4-6)
