Kitchen get help from rival to reach playoffs

ANCHORAGE – On a night cold enough that even a crow could see its breath in the wind, Anchorage Kitchen supporters felt cozy and warm as they reveled inside the Eastside headquarters of the rival Willow Weasels.


Willow's improbable Brett Favre-led comeback had just made it possible for the Kitchen to clinch its first playoff berth since the 1995 season, when it won the Sweeney Bowl.

"After five years of bad luck, I'm finally back in the hunt," jubilant Anchorage owner Nate Sagan said. "On one night it seemed to all fall in place."

Anchorage already had the inside track on the sixth and final berth, but Monday night's game would decide six games on the TFL docket, and the Ghost of Monday Night Miracles Past was predicting a Derrick Fenner second-comeing in the body of Stacey Mack.

But late in the first half things began to fall into place as Favre shoveled a scoring pass to Ahman Green, tightening the noose on Narcoossee's playoff hopes.


And as the game wore on and it became evident that Stacey Mack couldn't out-

run Charles Bingham to a table-dancer, Sagan could breathe a sigh of relief.

With only the luckless Experiments remaining in the playoff hunt with Sagan, the focus turned to Van Williams and his team's improbable comeback.

Having just returned from the minus-20 temperatures in the foothills of the Chugach Mountains, Williams stared bleary-eyed at the television. The Willow owner had just completed a 12-hour reconnaissance mission to hunt for Taliban sympathasizers, and he couldn't believe his eyes when he saw Favre's numbers late in the third quarter – 3 TDs, 276 yards.

"I couldn't still win, could

I?" Williams asked.

Figuring he needed just a pair long passes and one more touchdown, a down-trodden Williams showed a sparkle in his eye. If Eddie George had actually scored a touchdown Sunday, then things were obviously going right. Sure enough, Favre piled a rushing touchdown and more anguish on Dugway's faithful fans.

But in Anchorage it was a sigh of relief for the Kitchen, who can rest its starters for the next two weeks in preparations for a Marshall Faulk-led run at its second Sweeney Bowl title.

"Scott Gomez really sucks, so this town hasn't had much to cheer about this year," Williams maligned.

Inside the numbers

The fans ask, and Merwin has answers

Well, the staff here at Inside the Numbers has been overwhelmed this week with questions and comments from the very owners we cover. So let's rip open the mailbag and see where this week's edition of ITN is heading.

The envelopes, please.

■ **Pretty Putrid Play** — Alert reader Chris Reidy had this question: "Have there ever been eight teams below .500 at this point in the season?"

Well, Chris, the answer is yes. In 1998, eight of the TFL's 14 teams were below .500 enter Week 13. But a late push by Flint and Dutch Harbor reduced that number to six by season's end. Narcoossee and Willow both need to win their final two games this season to achieve the same finish this year.

In the process of researching Reidy's question, we also came across some related trivia. In 1999, entering Week 13, all five teams in the Barbarino Division were below .500. The Newts wound up winning the Barbarino title that year with a 7-6-1 record

■ **Trading Places** — Flint owner Don Carlock left us a message on our voicemail here at ITN. First, he chuckled about his team's ample good fortune in 2001, then noted that if Flint and Dugway played each other's schedule, both teams would be 7-5 — as opposed to their current marks of 10-2 and 4-8, respectively.

It's no wonder. Flint and Dugway have cut strikingly different paths through the TFL this season. The Tubes have outscored the Bison 482-457, yet still trail the Bison but a staggering six games.

How did that happen?

Easy. Flint posts three one-point victories (the most in one season in

TFL history) and Dugway loses three games by three points or fewer.

Stay tuned while Dugway owner Ken Sain makes his annual bid to overturn Prop 5.

■ **QB Power** — Long-time TFL fan Milton Sputum of Yeehaw Junction, Fla., writes: "Dear Merwin. I notice that the top eight scorers in the TFL this year are quarterbacks. Is that unusual?"

Yes, Merwin, it is. In fact, it's unprecedented. The folks here at ITN sifted through the TFL archives and discovered that never before had the top eight point-scorers through Week 12 been quarterbacks.

So are we witnessing the reemergence of the TFL quarterback, a return to the days of Marino, Kelly, Moon and Montana? Perhaps. But just as large a factor has been the lack of non-quarterback scorers. Emmitt Smith and Terrell Davis are fading into the pasture, Edgerrin James is hurt, and once-dominating receivers like Jerry Rice and Cris Carter are no longer in their peak scoring years.

Couple that with the emergence of young QB studs like Jeff Garcia, Daunte Culpepper, Donovan McNabb and Brian Griese, and it's easy to see why the TFL leaderboard is dominated by signal-callers.

Manning scoring loads of points, for Colts and foes

Peyton finds his place in record book

JUNEAU, Alaska — By all accounts, Indianapolis quarterback Peyton Manning has had a successful season for the Alaska Oosiks, justifying his selection in the first round of the TFL draft.

Manning has posted respectable numbers, completing 245 of his 387 attempts this season (63.3 percent) for 3,019 yards and 20 touchdowns. His yardage total is second only to Kurt Warner's 3,342. His 20 touchdowns trail only Jeff Garcia's and Brett Favre's 24, Warner's 22, Rich Gannon's 21 each (Brian Griese also has 20 TDs).

Manning has scored 172 points in the TFL, second only to the 183 scored by Garcia (Favre is tied with Manning).

By those accounts, Manning has had a good year. But there's one irksome quality that has Alaska Oosiks owner Charles Bingham wishing Manning's Indianapolis Colts faced the Philadelphia Eagles every week of the season. That way the Oosiks, who also have the TFL's top-ranked Philly defense, would get the defensive points every time Manning throws an interception that's returned for a touchdown.

Manning's tendency to



throw the ball into traffic has resulted in his 17 interceptions being tied with Trent Green for the most this season. On Sunday, Manning had his sixth interception returned for a touchdown this year. If he was facing the Philly defense, at least the Oosiks would have another 36 points.

The six defensive touchdowns off Manning's interceptions are as many touchdowns as Pittsburgh Steelers QB Kordell Stewart has thrown to his own AFC-leading team-

mates. It's more than the five touchdowns each thrown by Seattle's Matt Hasselbeck, Buffalo's Rob Johnson, Chicago's Shane Matthews and Dallas' Anthony Wright.

Manning's interception touchdowns are also more than the touchdown totals of these quarterbacks who have appeared on TFL rosters this year — Randall Cunningham (3), Trent Dilfer (2), Drew Bledsoe (2), Gus Frerotte (1), Drew Brees (1), Michael Vick (1), Quincy Carter (1) and Ryan Leaf (1). A couple of these

That gives him almost as many TDs to the wrong team, as Bagdad quarterbacks have thrown this year — combined.

QB's still are on a few TFL rosters this week.

There are several top-rated quarterbacks who haven't even thrown six interceptions this season — Gannon (4), Stewart (5), Mark Brunell (6) and Donovan McNabb (6). Even Jeff George only had three INTs before he got cut.

So, as the season heads into its final stretch, the Alaska Oosiks have only one thought — it's a good thing interceptions don't count against quarterback scoring in the TFL.
